**SUBJECT: INTRA/INTER-DISTRICT AGREEMENTS FOR THE 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR**

While students are generally expected to attend the school in their area of residence, the California Education Code and policies of the Roseville City School District's Board of Education do allow options for students wanting to attend a school outside their established attendance area. Based on the provisions of the law and the applicable Board policies, the Roseville City School District presents the following information:

## **DEFINITIONS**

**Intra-District:** Students who reside within the Roseville City School District boundary who wish to attend a school outside their attendance boundary area.

**Inter-District:** Students who reside outside of the Roseville City School District boundary who wish to attend a school within the Roseville City School District; or students who reside inside the Roseville City School District boundary who wish to attend a school in another district. **Parents residing outside of the Roseville City School District Boundaries must initiate this process at their school district of residence.**

**PLEASE NOTE:** *All renewal requests for current inter-district agreements of Roseville City School District students attending schools outside of the district will be approved. However, due to the severe funding deficit we are experiencing from the state; new inter-district requests to attend schools outside the district may be denied for the 2010-2011 school year.*

## **APPLICATIONS**

Applications for intra/inter-district attendance agreements are available at each of the school sites and at the District Office. Those with current intra-district attendance agreements **DO NOT** have to resubmit their applications. **All applications must be returned to the Roseville City School District, 1050 Main St., Roseville, California, 95678. Applications will ONLY be accepted at the District Office** since submitting your application to a school site could jeopardize the timely processing of your application.

## **RANDOM AND UNBIASED SELECTION PROCESS**

If there are more applications than spaces available at your requested school and grade level, the district will conduct a lottery of those applications submitted during the open enrollment period. The lottery will determine which applications are approved and establish a ranked order as future openings become available.

## **DEADLINE**

**Applications will be accepted from February 1, 2010 through March 12, 2010, to be considered for the "random and unbiased" selection process.** Applications received after that date will be given a number as they are received at the District Office and will be addressed in the order they are received.

## **PROCEDURES**

- ❖ Students who live in the attendance area of a particular school will be given priority to attend that school over students who do not live in the school's attendance area.
- ❖ Once enrolled, intra-district transfer students (those who reside within the Roseville City School District) **do not** have to apply annually for readmission to the school outside the attendance area in which they reside. (BP 5116.1[a])
- ❖ Fifth/Sixth grade students holding a current **intra-district** agreement for attendance at one of Roseville City School District's elementary schools will automatically roll over into that elementary school's feeder middle/intermediate school.
- ❖ Inter-district transfer students (those who reside outside the Roseville City School District) **will need** to reapply annually regardless of their grade level.
- ❖ **Notification of acceptance or denial will be mailed to the applicant as soon as the determination is made.**

## **TRANSPORTATION**

The district does not provide special transportation for intra/inter-district students.
