

Terms And Conditions For The Use of Roseville City School District Access to the Internet

- STEP 1 Our goal in providing this service is to promote educational excellence by facilitating resource sharing, innovation, and communication.
- STEP 2 Along with access to computers and people all over the world comes the availability of material that may not be considered of educational value in a school setting. We have taken precautions to restrict access to controversial materials by teaching students about responsible use and by using software to block student access to inappropriate materials.

- Acceptable Use

The purpose of the Internet and its service providers is to support research and education in and among academic institutions in the U.S. by providing access to unique resources and the opportunity for collaborative work. The use of your account must be in support of education and research and be consistent with the educational objectives of Roseville City School District (RCSD) schools. Use of other organizations' networks or computing resources must comply with the rules appropriate for that network. Transmission of any material in violation of any U.S. or state regulation is prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to: copyrighted material, threatening or obscene material, or material protected by trade secret.

Use for commercial activities by for-profit institutions or individuals are prohibited. Use for product advertisement or political lobbying is also prohibited.

- Privileges

The use of RCSD access to the Internet is a **privilege, not a right**, and inappropriate use will result in a cancellation of those privileges. The District retains the right to review any material on users, accounts. The system manager, school administrator, and sponsoring staff will deem what is inappropriate use, and their decision shall be final. Examples of inappropriate uses include, but are not limited to: transmission of unlawful information on the network, improper access, misappropriation or misuse of information/files of other users, and the use of obscene, abusive, or otherwise offensive or objectionable language in either public or private messages. An account may be closed at any time as required.

- Warranties

RCSD makes no warranties of any kind, whether expressed or implied, for the service it is providing and will not be responsible for any damages suffered. This includes loss of data resulting from delays, non-deliveries, mis-deliveries, or service interruptions caused by negligence, errors, or omissions. Use of any information obtained via RCSD access to the Internet is at your own risk. RCSD specifically denies any responsibility for the accuracy or quality of information obtained through its services. All information obtained through Internet access is placed there for general information purposes and is in no way intended to refer to, or be application to, any specific person, case, or situation.

- Security

Security on any computer system is a high priority, especially when the system involves many users. Do not use another individual's account. Attempts to login through RCSD to the Internet as another user will result in cancellation of user privileges. Any user identified as a security risk or having a history of problems with other computer systems may be denied access.

- Vandalism

Vandalism will result in cancellation of privileges. Vandalism is defined as any willful or malicious attempt to harm or destroy data of another user or any of the agencies or other networks that are connected to PCOE, SCOE, or any other service provider. This includes, but is not limited to, the uploading or creation of computer viruses.

- Updating Your User Information

RCSD access to the Internet requires annual review of user agreement and periodic update of account information for continued service. You must notify your school of any changes in your account information.
