The Budget trailer bill (SBX3 4) gives districts the authority to use the funds received from the State for Tier III programs for "any educational purpose, to the extent permitted by federal law." The flexibility to transfer funds from these programs is authorized for five years from the 2008-09 year through 2012-13. In order to exercise this transfer authority for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the district is required to hold a public hearing and requests public input on the flexibility transfers.
