The Roseville City School District (RCSD) is a vibrant learning community full of dedicated parents, engaged students and committed educators all focused on providing the best educational experience possible.

During the 2015/16 school year, we:

- Increased the number of Transitional Kindergarten classes offered throughout the district
- Reduced student-to-teacher ratios in all of our Transitional Kindergarten through 3rd grade classes to a school average of 24:1
- Added a counselor at all of our middle schools
- Provided additional staff members at our three Title I schools in order to provide direct support to students and families
- Implemented a new math curriculum
- Hired additional personnel within the Maintenance and Facilities Department to keep our schools beautiful and well-maintained

For the 2016/17 school year, we are:

- Launching a new elementary music education program for every Kindergarten through 5th grade student
- Providing an upgraded wireless network infrastructure at every site
- Introducing a new student management and assessment system
- Implementing a new K-5 English Language Arts curriculum
- Completing construction on a new elementary school in our district's western boundary

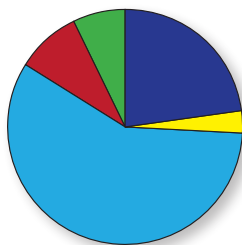
