

2017-18 Inter/Intra District Transfer Application Information

Frequently Asked Questions

I've submitted an Outgoing Interdistrict Transfer for 2017-18, when will it be reviewed?

Beginning in February 2017 the District will start reviewing all new applications. Once a decision is made, if approved, the application will be mailed to the requested district. If denied, RCSD will send a letter. All **New** applications, upon verification of communication with the RCSD home school principal, and all supporting documentation is included, the application will be reviewed by the District.

Do I need to submit an Interdistrict Transfer to attend a RCSD school if I'm currently on one?

Yes, Interdistrict transfers need to be done each year.

Why do I need to meet with my RCSD home school Principal?

We, as a District, would like the opportunity to address any needs and/or concerns that our parents & students are seeking to fill in another district.

Do I need to submit an Intradistrict transfer if I am <u>currently</u> on one for the 2016-17 year?

No.

EXCEPTION: If you are a 5th grader who desires to attend a middle school that is not your resident middle school, even if you have been on an Intra at your current elementary site you must submit a new Intra form.

I've turned in my application <u>during</u> open enrollment, *January 4th through January 27th*, when will I be notified of a decision?

We are expecting to notify parents by the end of March via US Mail.

I've turned in my application <u>after</u> the open enrollment period, *January 4th through January 27th*, when can I expect to be notified of a decision?

We are expecting to notify parents within a 60-day window after application has been submitted.
