BACKGROUND AND SUMMARY (Overview):

The passage of Proposition 30 in November 2012 required several accountability measures for school districts, including:

- Requires school governing boards to make spending determinations at an open session of a public meeting
- Prohibits funds from being used for administrative costs
- · Requires districts to annually publish an accounting of funds on its website
- Inclusion of Proposition 30 revenues and expenditures in annual financial audits

For Fiscal Year 2020-21, it is estimated the District will receive \$8,247,840 in funding as a result of the passage of Proposition 30; 100% of these funds will be used for teacher salaries and benefits. This public hearing is an opportunity for the public to comment on the District's proposed use of these funds for the 2020-21 fiscal year.
