At the middle school level (grades 6–8), students are offered a diverse array of arts courses, including dance, visual arts, band, and choir. These programs are designed to foster creativity, collaboration, and an appreciation for the arts while supporting the social-emotional and academic growth of students. Course offerings vary by site based on student interest and staffing, but all students have access to high-quality arts instruction.
