Frequently Asked Questions

Are you looking for the experience of a lifetime? Interested in creating a connection with a student from France or Spain? Want the experience of hosting a foreign exchange student without the long commitment? If so, this is the place for you!

Purpose:

Students are here to participate in a homestay program to practice speaking English and to live the "real life" of an American family. Students want to meet a family and create a lasting relationship. Most students will attend other American Discovery sponsored trips (*Possible Trips: San Francisco, Tahoe, and/or Sunsplash*).

Host Families:

- Share 2-3 weeks of your life with exchange students
- Only cost to the families is food lodging
- Students are fully insured and bring spending money

How old are the students?

The students in this group are 14-19.

What if I don't have an extra bedroom?

Students can share a bedroom with you as long as there is a blow up mattress or bed for them to sleep on.

What if my parents are divorced?

If both of your parents are willing, the student can follow you wherever you go. They are here to experience the life of an American teenager.

What can I do with the students?

They love doing anything you are doing. They are teenagers just like you. They love shopping, going to the movies, hanging out with friends, and just being with your family.

What will the students do while I am at school?

It may be possible for the student to attend school with you. On the other school days, trips will be provided to the students during school hours.

Can I get in touch with them now?

Once your family signs up you will receive a packet with all of the student's information. They are eager to hear from you so you are welcome to write or email them.
