The City of Roseville and Placer County are beginning a Planning & Feasibility Study for the Dry Creek Greenway West.

This study will evaluate the possibility of a 3-mile multi-use, paved trail between Cook Riolo Road and Riverside Avenue. This potential trail would ultimately connect with the existing Dry Creek Greenway in unincorporated Placer County, west of Cook Riolo Road and the proposed Dry Creek Greenway East (Riverside Avenue to Old Auburn Road).

The Dry Creek Greenway is just one of the trails in the City of Roseville and Placer County Bicycle Master Plan.
