WHAT'S NEW

- The Board of Education will discuss implications of the new <u>guidance</u> at the February 4 board meeting.
- Placer County Public Health (PCPH) was forced to change the order of those eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine when the Governor announced the inclusion of people aged 65 and older into Phase 1A Tier 3. Unfortunately, this negatively impacts the timelines for Phase IB Tier 1 groups, including educators. PCPH does not have a timeline for Phase IB Tier 1 at this time.



REGISTRATION REMINDERS

- <u>Student registration</u> is open for the 2021-2022 school year. Registering early allows each school and program to be staffed with the best candidates.
- When registering, we will gauge parent interest for in-person and exclusive distance learning through the Champions Academy. Families will select their program preference for the next school year, keeping in mind this is not a final commitment.
- Families will commit to in-person instruction or the Champions Academy in the spring when more information is available.



HEALTH REMINDERS

- If a student isn't feeling well or has COVID-19 symptoms, they must immediately quarantine and contact their school so our nurse can follow up with additional information.
- As a cautionary measure, if a family member is awaiting a COVID-19 test, awaiting results, or potentially exposed to a positive case, we ask you to selfquarantine your children until results are in.



STILL HAPPENING!

- The RCSD <u>COVID-19 dashboard</u> containing each school's positive case numbers is updated daily and available on our district <u>website</u>.
- Surveillance testing is available to all RCSD staff twice monthly. There is an appointment only COVID-19 testing site in Roseville at the Maidu Activity Center. Schedule testing at https://linearcycovidtesting or call 888.634.1123.
- There is also an appointment only COVID-19 testing site at Placer County Office of Education, 655 Menlo Drive, Rocklin for exposed students and RCSD staff.
