PROGRESS MADE LAST WEEK

- The Board of Education met this week and approved the return of students to a modified traditional school schedule (Stage IV) on November 4, 2020.
- The Champions Academy will start on November 4, 2020.

WHAT WE KNOW

- The modified traditional school schedule will adhere to all of the California Department of Public Health Guidelines.
- The modified traditional schedule includes 5 hours of in-person instruction, 5 days a week, with a grab-and-go lunch.
- Schedules will be provided by each school.
- Class sizes will range between 24-34 students.
- Transportation is only available to students who have it written into their IEP.
- The ASD and FSP programs will operate in their current schedule.

CHALLENGES STILL AHEAD

- Those families who want to change their program selection based on the move to a modified traditional schedule need to complete an [intradistrict transfer](#) request by 10/19.
- This is only a request and program changes are not guaranteed.
- Student schedules will be completed the week of 10/26 to accommodate as many transfer requests as possible.
