WHAT WE KNOW

- COVID-19 cases are upticking as predicted and we've worked very hard to open our schools safely and want to remain open.
- Placer County Public Health states that reopening schools is not contributing to the increase in COVID-19 cases.
- The California Blueprint for a Safer Economy color coded tier system has no impact on our ability to remain open for in-person learning.
- Once a school opens, it may remain open unless there is a 5% positive case rate on campus.
