## WHAT'S NEW THIS WEEK

### PROGRESS MADE LAST WEEK

- We aligned our quarantine procedures at the middle school level with health department guidelines so that only those who have been within 6 feet for 15 minutes of a confirmed or presumed positive COVID-19 case will need to quarantine, rather than an entire class or cohort.
- The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) issued updated face covering guidance on November 16, 2020. This updated guidance mandates that a face covering is required at all times when outside of the home, with some exceptions. The updated guidance supersedes previous CDPH guidance and is reflected in our Reopen and Remain Open Plan.
- The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recently released revised quarantine timelines. The California Department of Public Health will review the revised quarantine timelines and provide guidance to Placer County Public Health in the near future.

### WHAT WE KNOW

- The imminent Regional Stay Home Orders announced on December 3, 2020, specifically allow schools to remain open.
