#### **REMINDER FOR 2021-22 REGISTRATION**

- <u>Student registration</u> is happening for the 2021-22 school year! While our numbers are strong, we believe there are still about 25% of families who still need to register. Please register ASAP so that we are able to plan appropriately for the 2021-22 school year.
- When registering, we will gauge parent interest for in-person and exclusive distance learning through the Champions Academy. Families will select their program preference for the next school year, keeping in mind this is not a final commitment.
- Families will commit to in-person instruction or the Champions Academy in April when more information is available.



### **VACCINATION + HEALTH REMINDERS**

- Vaccinations are now available to Phase 1B Tier One, who are 65+, and those in education, childcare, emergency services, and food and agriculture.
- If a student isn't feeling well or has COVID-19 symptoms, they must immediately quarantine and contact their school so our nurse can follow up with additional information.
- As a cautionary measure, if a family member is awaiting a COVID-19 test, awaiting results, or potentially exposed to a positive case, we ask you to self-quarantine your children until results are in.
