WHAT WE KNOW

- In-person learning for ASD and FSP classes begins 9/30/2020.
- Placer County is progressing toward the orange tier on the California Blueprint For a Safer Economy scale.
- School Board Meeting - 10/1/2020: Discuss criteria for reopening schools in a 5-day per week model with additional health and safety measures (Stage IV).

CHALLENGES STILL AHEAD

- Determining if Placer County progresses from the red tier to the orange tier on the California Blueprint For a Safer Economy scale, is it possible to move to Stage IV of the Reopen and Remain Open plan on November 4, 2020.
- Stage IV is a traditional 5-day per week model with enhanced health and safety measures.
- Transportation is available only for Special Education students who have it written into their IEP.
