Apple TV's & Technology Plan 2017-18	Discussion	Rachel Morse & Angela Garcia	Rachel Morse, Kindergarten teacher, shared the ways she is using the Apple TV package in the classroom with her students. Through PTC funds the packages were bought for all of our K and 1st grade classrooms this school year. PTC has designated technology funds to buy the packages for 2nd grade classroom and continuing into 3rd grade after our walk a thon. Rachel presented how students are engaged in Benchmark curriculum on the Apple TV projection. She showed how she uses Class Dojo as a positive reinforcement system for students and is able to project this for the students. Rachel hopes to begin using this as a sharing device as students are completing tasks on their own iPads and will now have the ability to share and project this through the Apple TV. Question was asked to Rachel about the difference between SMARTboard and Apple TVs and the possibilities. Apps on the iPad allows students to use the iPad similar to touching the SMARTboard. The Apple TV has more mobility in the way that students can be mobile while they are working on the iPad that is projecting. Rachel is using the Apple TV for most whole group activities along with the class dojo while students are working.

CAASPP Results	Discussion	Angela Garcia	2016-17 CAASPP data was shared with the team which showed overall data from 2015-2017 as well as cohort data which shows the same group of students and their progress from 3rd to 5th grade. Angela also projected claims data which breaks down the ELA and Math CAASPP data into subgroups to show trends over time. Angela shared how the staff are meeting four times throughout the year to discuss data and specific

			student needs. This time will come during the school day using site funds for substitute teachers. Intervention time has been made consistent across grade levels as well this year. Site council asked that an update be given at a future meeting of how we are using the CAASPP data and what our next steps are as a building.
