

TRANSITIONAL KINDERGARTEN

- Eligible students must turn 5 years old between July 1, 2018 and on or before January 31, 2019. Priority enrollment will be given to students with birthdays between September 2 and December 2. Students with birthdays between December 3, 2018 and January 31, 2019 will be placed for fall enrollment if space is available. Registration is available on the Roseville City School District Website.
- For the 2018-2019 school year we hope to provide Transitional Kindergarten at all elementary school sites. This is subject to enrollment numbers and could change.
- TK students will attend class for 200 instructional minutes each day (about 3 hrs and 20 min/day), Monday through Friday. TK students will follow the district calendar. The 2018-2019 school calendar will be posted when it has been approved by the Board of Education.
- Transitional Kindergarten is defined as “the first year of a two-year kindergarten program that uses a modified kindergarten curriculum that is age and developmentally appropriate.”
- Kindergarten readiness is the primary goal of the TK program, which focuses on language and literacy activities as well as early math skills. There is a strong emphasis on social, emotional, and motor skill development. Transitional Kindergarten might be the perfect fit for your child.
- TK teachers are fully credentialed and will utilize a transitional kindergarten curriculum aligned with the California State Standards.
- Transportation is the responsibility of the parent/guardian.
- There is no cost for this program.
